

## For My Husband:

**1** Pray that God would be on the throne of his heart. "Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy strength, and with all thy mind; and thy neighbor as thyself." Luke 10: 27

**2** Pray that his heart would be knit with the hearts of your children. "And he shall turn the heart of the fathers to the children, And the heart of the children to their fathers." Malachi 4: 6

"The aged women likewise, that they be in behavior as becometh holiness, not false accusers, not given to much wine, teachers of good things; that they may teach the younger women to be sober [of a sound mind], to love their husbands, to love their children, to be discreet [self-controlled, moderate as to opinion or passion], chaste [pure, modest, refraining from actions or thoughts or desires that are not sanctioned by marriage vows], keepers at home, good, obedient to their husbands, that the word of God be not blasphemed. In all things shewing thyself a pattern of good works: in doctrine shewing uncorruptness, gravity, sincerity, sound speech that cannot be condemned." Titus 2:3- 8

**17** "Lead me, O Lord, in thy righteousness... Make thy way straight before my face," and "Open thou mine eyes, That I may behold wondrous things out of thy law." Psalm 5:8; 119: 18
